What is Skin Relief?

Skin Relief Lotion contains a light blend of oils specifically formulated to help the skin repair itself. This lotion also contains a high (extra Strength) concentration of Therosol®, a proprietary and patent-pending Phytomodifier™ that can calm and soothe skin and reduce the appearance of redness caused by a variety of skin disorders. Therosol® has been clinically proven to improve skin dryness and texture over a four week period. Skin Relief Lotion is gentle enough to use on rosacea and eczema prone skin without causing irritation.

What are some of the ingredients in Skin Relief?

Capric/Caprylic Triglyceride

- This ingredient is a naturally occurring triglyceride from coconut oil, as well as from other plants. It is an extremely stable ingredient and is an excellent vehicle & solvent for active ingredients. It is so gentle and safe for the skin that it is often used at concentrations as high or higher than 50% in cosmetic formulations.

Niacinamide (Vitamin B₃)

- Niacinamide is the amide form of Vitamin B₃. This vitamin has been shown to have a variety of beneficial effects on skin including improving skin hydration, reducing inflammation and acting as an antioxidant. Niacinamide may also help boost energy production in skin cells.

Vitamin E Acetate

- Vitamin E Acetate is an excellent antioxidant and helps protect the skin by neutralizing free radicals. Vitamin E Acetate is also photoprotective and protects the skin against UVR damage.

Glycerin

- This is an excellent humectant which absorbs and retains moisture. It is extremely mild on skin and can be used at high concentrations.

Therosol®

- Therosol® is a proprietary and patent-pending botanically derived ingredient discovered by Therametics' scientists. Therosol is prepared for Therametics in highly (99.8%) pure form for use in this product. Laboratory research studies using cultured human skin cells have shown that Therosol® can reduce the production of a variety of inflammatory hormones (cytokines and chemokines) that are responsible for triggering skin inflammation, causing redness, irritation and skin damage. Therosol® has also been shown to increase collagen and elastin production in cultured human dermal fibroblasts.

How do I use Skin Relief?

After cleansing skin with Therametics' Foaming Facial Cleanser, apply Skin Relief evenly and liberally to all affected areas of the skin. Because Skin Relief has an "Extra Strength" amount of Therosol, you may experience mild tingling or warmth when first applied. This will subside in a minute or two. Because of its calming and moisturizing properties Skin Relief can be applied as frequently as necessary to affected skin. It's calming effects are particularly useful on sunburned or eczema affected skin. For best results it should be used at least twice a day. If using in combination with Dermal Repair Serum, sunscreen or other topical product, make sure one product is completely absorbed into the skin before applying the other. As with any product, if irritation develops discontinue use.

Are there any concerns regarding the use of Skin Relief?

No Sunscreen - Skin Relief does not contain any sunscreen. Because of this if the product is going to be applied in the morning to sun exposed areas, it is recommended that a lightly moisturizing lotion with an SPF of 15 or higher be applied to these areas after Skin Relief has completely absorbed into the skin.
